A MIRACLE FOR MAGIDU

It happened in October 2012, The young boy of 10 was playing with his friends in a remote village in Uganda in the district of Bugiri, They were having fun until Magidu fell into a pit and broke his two femur bones. He had no medical attention .

In Kampala, Dr. Gilbert Buringi has a Medical Clinic, each month he and his assistants of 20 choose a village to hold a Free Medical Clinic, where they travel many miles to treat the needy. In March 2013, Dr. Gil-

bert traveled to the remote village close to where Magidu lives. It was there he met Magidu after his mother carried him on her back for a mile to see the Doctor.

She didn't know it then nor did Dr. Gilbert, that she was walking to a Divine Appointment.

Dr. Gilbert quickly examined him and saw the dire need for Magidu to have medical treatment. He arranged to have Magidu and his mother travel by ambulance to Kampala where Dr. Gilbert

quickly began Medical treatment, for Magidu had not long to live. Because of the 6 month time period, the severe infection had taken over his small injured body.

We prayed. God supplied the funding through his people for the medical treatment and the 4 hour surgery was performed on April 29th 2013.

Magidu recovered from the surgery very well, and was placed in traction for 10 days, to enable him to stand and sit correct

He placed a Skype call to me, and when I answered, he turned the camera toward Magidu, Oh, my eyes filled with tears of joy as I saw our many prayers answered when I noticed Magidu not only standing straight and tall, but WALKING back and forth!! Praise The Lord! Dr. Gilbert stayed with them for sometime, ministering to them, answering any questions they may have had.

Later in the day I received another Skype call from my dear friend, Dr. Gilbert—he was delighted and his spirit was soaring—he had the privilege of sharing the Gospel with Magidu's mother, Halima, and she and Magidu along with 2 others prayed to receive Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. Hallelujah!

She met the One Whose Love she was seeing in all the weeks of treatment and care her son was receiving, God Almighty, The One True God, The Lord Jesus Christ.

As I continue this testimony, today is the 25 of June, the day Magidu was to go to Kampala for his check-up—

The Doctor examined the young boy

and said he has been **completely healed!** He can run, jump, play, work, dance and go to school. Hallelujah!! This boy was brought back from the brink of death not only healed in his body, but healed in his soul, as he has new life in Jesus Christ.

And we met a man, John who heard the suggestion of his pastor to try Prison Ministry, and a man we worked with years before, introduced us. In Johns' words, "Oh, I'll try it for a few weeks" and continues to minister weekly in a County Jail.— **God's plan.**

John introduced us to Mike, who has built our website and helps with this paper, who also

has become an Assistant Chaplain teaching in the Faith-based Dorm. **God's plan.**

We met Steve, who had served a term in Fed. Prison, years ago, was praying for a place to serve, joined our team and ministers in music at our services. **God's Plan.**

Being invited to a Sat. Bible study, we met Fred & Sally, whom upon meeting became instant friends. Upon the invitation from Mack to join our team, Fred, wasn't too sure about going to Jail/Prison Ministry, and a few weeks passed, as he prayed, God's answer was, "*I want you to be available to Me.*" now Fred & Sally serve faithfully every 3rd Monday at the County Jail church. **God's plan.**

Mike, John & Fred are involved with Welcome Back Texas, A parole ministry in Palo Pinto County. **God's plan**

While we ministered at CCA for several years, the chaplains clerk escorted us to the Chapel,

He was friendly, and we saw that he truly loved the Lord. In 2007 Rodney finished his parole, and called to visit us, he & his wife Kathy were asked to join our team, and the Jail approved his application. They minister each 1st Monday, plus offer a Bible study through this paper and has started a church in their home.

Several years back John lead a ministry called Mercy Heart, it was there we met Jack, a man with a desire to preach the Word of God. Jack came with us several times, and found his place of service with us. **God's plan.**

Others have served along with us, through the years, but have

left to serve elsewhere and were such blessings to those they ministered to. **God's plan.**

The others on our ministry team are you, our dear friends who write your testimonies and devotionals for this paper. You are in God's plan for the success of this newsletter.

USE WHAT YOU ARE and HAVE... TO GET TO NEXT LEVEL..

Everyone in this world has something, talent or an inborn skill that can be used to not only transform their personal lives but also impact the communities around them.

First I will talk of the Widow of Zareph in the book of 1Kings 17;7-13, when Elijah reached this woman and requested for something to eat, the widow replied "..... I don't have any bread...only a handful of flour in a jar and a little oil....." First imagine this, wasn't there some body of well standing status where God would have sent his servant to have something to eat other than sending him to a desperate Widow? Secondly wouldn't God have prevented the brook from drying up? So the question is why did God in His sovereignty allow all this to happen the way it happened?

The Bible clearly says that every where Jesus went he felt compassion, for the needy people. Without God's intervention in this woman's circumstance, this woman together with her child would have starved to death. It necessitated Elijah to obey the voice of God to go to this widow and it also necessitated the widow to obey the word of God that Elijah spoke to her in order for her to survive death. Another time as I prayed to God to deliver me from bad clothing i.e putting on worn out clothes that didn't suit a servant of God like me, the Spirit of God quickened my spirit to give out all the clothes I had, this really seemed hard for me to do because I didn't actually know where I was to get replacements but because I was so sure that it was the Spirit of God leading me to do this, I did obey, I gave out the clothes. I remained with just the shirt and trouser I had worn, my life started to change for the better.

Many times the Lord will test your obedience to Him. Actually the Lord many times tests our obedience in times of scarcity. He told Abraham "take your son Isaac and offer him as a sacrifice to me "after Abraham, obeying the voice of God, we see God saying "I swear by myself, declares the Lord that because you have not withheld your son ...I will bless you ..." God tested Abraham in what he had.

When Moses was instructed by God to deliver the children of Israel, he was afraid, he never believed in Himself, God asked "what do you have in your hands?" We took some clothes and other basic gifts to give to the brethren. Indeed the Tanzanian brethren gave us a good welcome, the pastor that hosted us together with his wife are of Ugandan descent, so we really felt at home.

We taught the WORD to a receptive congregation. As we ministered, we shared with them some of the testimonies that are in the FLN and they felt so much blessed. We distributed the copies we had, but we couldn't give each a copy due to the limited copies we took with us, so the pastor assured us that he would make sure that at least each of them would read its contents

Our 4 day Tanzanian meetings comprised of pastors and gospel ministers and were so much edified by the Gospel I personally taught. One thing that is unforgettable about the Tanzanian mission is this; in one of the services, as I shared my life testimony, I found my self burst in tears, in the same spirit, even the congregation I ministered to, was swept in tears. The Spirit of God hovered over the entire congregation. God was meeting the hearts of His people, in that very service a lot of people came forward to be restored in their faith.

I have ministered in lots of places but I think my Tanzanian experience will never be forgotten. WHAT MANNER OF LOVE

We would grimace. We would quickly shift our gaze. Surely we would turn from such a sight. It's not easy to look at dead and decaying flesh, especially when it's sloughing off the live body of a man reaching out to touch us.

"UNCLEAN...UNCLEAN." the leper proclaims as he descends the mountain. We would nod in agreement and add a few adjectives of our own. Frightful. Hideous. Grotesque. We love to label things. That's what the usual crowd does.

The usual crowd despises him. The usual crowd runs at the sight of him. The leper dared not come down from the mountain at any other time: the words that were cast at him hurt as much as the stones that were hurled. Bruising words that wound deeper than the leprosy ever could.

This day he risks insults and injury. Despite the usual crowd, this day he comes to see a man. A special man. A kind, compassionate, understanding man. Even from his isolated life on top of the mountain he hears of Jesus.

"UNCLEAN.... UNCLEAN!" the crowd makes a wide path as the leper approaches. Some, holding their stones tightly gripped fists, knuckles white with hatred, resist the urge to strike at the man. Others, ready to hurl their hurtful words, words made bitter by the venom of their hearts, remain silent. Expectation freezes the crowd in the grips.

All eyes shift from the leper to Jesus. "What's He going to do? Could this man who has healed many by touching them, touch a leper?"

Yes, He can.

And He does.

With a trembling voice, the leper speaks as he stands before the Savior. "If you w-w- will, you can m-m-make me clean." Mouth twisted from leprosy,

facial muscles paralyzed by decay, the words are barely discernible. Jesus hears each word clearly, because he hears the words before they leave the heart—the words cry loudly there. Jesus is moved with compassion.

Without fear.

Without hesitation.

Without a critical thought.

Jesus touches him. "I will. Be clean!"

In a symphony of sighs, the crowd reacts, "Aaahhh! He touched him. What manner of love is this?"

Dead flesh meets the giver of life regenerates instantly before the eyes of the crowd. Smooth, flawless, youthful skin emerges. A fragrant bouquet replaces the smell of dead flesh.

When Jesus looks at a leper he doesn't see ugly. I think Jesus looked at the man and saw beauty. The beauty of a heart broken. A heart desperate. A heart longing. Jesus has a soft spot for broken, desperate, longing hearts. Only the perfect love of God could see the beauty beneath the ravaged flesh of a leper.

Only Jesus would touch it.

We all need His touch.

Whether we are a murderer, thief, rapist, or whether we're the best philanthropist doing good deeds all the days of our lives, absent Christ's touch, we are all spiritual lepers, dead and decaying in our sinfulness.

When we see the lust in our hearts.

When we recall the times we cheated someone.

When we count all the lies we told.

When we remember the persons we have hurt with our words and actions.

When we are mindful of the impure thoughts, wrong motives, the hidden things of our heart that nobody sees but us.

And Jesus.

We all are unclean before the Holy Standard of Christ Jesus.

It's why we need the Savior's touch. What Jesus did for the leper, he'll do for us. When we cry to Him in our uncleanness, He won't hesitate to touch us.

Maybe you never met Jesus. Oh, you've heard of Him. You heard of His great love. You heard of His many feats. You heard how He hung on a cross., died, then rose from the grave. But you have never met Him, never entrusted your life to Him. Oh, you may go to church regularly, may tithe faithfully, may hear the stories about Him. But you never met Him, never allowed Him to touch you.

"But you don't understand how unclean I am, don't understand what horrible things I have done." You've been too afraid to come down from your mountain of seclusion. You tried to come down once before, but stones were hurled at you. You're familiar with that hurtful crowd. The people jeered at you, turned their heads, turned up their noses.

"You don't belong in this church."

"We don't allow your kind here."

From your alcoholic gutter you emerged, your clothes putrid, only to be pushed away. Your heart burning with lust, addicted to pornography, you're too ashamed to come forward.

Selling your body to strangers for sex, you've allowed many defiling acts to be performed on you.

You feel unclean because of the life you have been living. You want a way out but don't know where to go. The usual crowd never receives you.

Then don't go to the usual crowd.

Go to Jesus. Deliverance, healing, cleansing, hope, salvation is not in a building, a place, a group, or organization—It's in a Person. Jesus

He'll accept you

He'll touch you.

He loves you. Just as you are. Before He was impaled by the nails that held Him to the cross, he was compelled by His love that held Him to you.

He won't turn you away.

He won't run at the sight of you.

He won't remind you of your past; He'll tell you of your future if you'll trust Him. The

leper envisioned something better. You envision something better. Oh, there are times of hopelessness when nothing better seems possible. There is often realization that there is always something better for others, but not for you. You feel trapped, imprisoned. But a part of you has to wonder. Even amidst the tears, the shame, the loneliness, the aching heart. Just maybe. .

These are the moments when Jesus will meet you. The times He will touch you. If you invite Him. "Jesus, if you will, You can make me clean."

When you're desperate enough, you'll risk it.

When you're tired of hurting.

When you're tired of losing.

When you're tired of broken relationships.

When you're tied of prison.

When you're tired of the needle.

When you're sick of the bottle.

You'll risk it.

You'll risk the name calling.

You'll risk the rock throwing.

Though the insults might sting,

you'll risk it. You want to be clean and you have heard about the One Who can do it. You'll say, "Jesus, if you will, you can make me clean."

He will. Ask Him, Pray this prayer:

Lord, I am coming to You. I need Your touch. Only You can make me clean. I give my life, my heart to You; all my sins, my pain, my shame, my guilt, the wounds of my heart. I confess my uncleanness, my sins to You and I repent, asking you to forgive me and deliver me. I am trusting you, for cleansing, forgiveness, salvation.
